Moses Lake Irrigation & Rehabilitation District (**MLIRD**) has been very active in the past three years bringing the lake and Connelly Park up to appropriate standards. While much has been accomplished in the area of beautification, and greater public usage and summer 2010 began the process of treating the lake body itself, it is time to continue with the lake treatment and with the management tools in place we have the ability to continue to implement the clean up process.

MLIRD has contracted Lakeland Restoration Services, LLC to perform aquatic herbicide treatments in the continued effort to control Eurasian Watermilfoil and other aquatic and riparian invasive nuisance plants from Moses Lake. The treatment will occur between the weeks of July 5th-8th, July 11th-15th and July 18th-22nd with a target start date of July 5th, 2011.

The permitting process and notification system of the State of Washington is being followed with the enclosed notification.

Please read the enclosed notice as to the specific treatment chemicals and restrictions.

This application will involve the use of airboats. Please remove items from docks such as lawn chairs, flower pots, personal/recreational floatation devices, etc.

Herbicide Treatment Business and Residential Notice

Distribution Date: June 24, 2011

Moses Lake will be treated with aquatic herbicide(s)/algaecide(s) on/or between July 5th and July 22nd.

In order to help prevent fragmentation, please DO NOT cut, rake, or hand-pull plants prior to treatment.

Product(s) planned for aquatic use:

- 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic acid, dimethylamine salt)
- Triclopyr: (3,5,6-trichloro-2-pyridinyl) Oxyacetic acid, triethylamine salt)
- Diquat dibromide [6,7-dihydrodipyrido (1,2-a:2',1'-c)
- Butoxyethyl ester, 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic acid)

It has been advised that no swimming occur within the treated area(s) during or for 24 hours following treatment.

If you are using the lake itself as a potable, irrigation and/or domestic or livestock water source, please contact Lakeland Restoration Services, LLC to determine if any restrictions apply.

Product(s) planned for riparian use:

- Imazapyr: Isopropylamine salt of Imazapyr (2-[4,5-dihydro-4-methyl-4-(1-methylethyl)-5-oxo-1H-imidazol-2-yl]-3-pyridinecarboxylic acid)*
- Glyphosate, N-(phosphonomethyl)glycine, in the form of its isopropylamine salt

Details of treatment time and the end of use restrictions will be announced at www.lakelandrs.com.

There is NO restriction for fishing or non-consumptive domestic uses.

Location of Treatment(s): Specific sites on Moses Lake.

Treated and potentially affected areas will be sign posted prior to application. The signs will describe any water use restrictions or advisories.

If you are withdrawing water for potable or domestic water use, livestock watering, or irrigation, and have no alternate water source, please contact the applicator Lakeland Restoration Services, LLC at (877) 273-6674 or info@lakelandrs.com to arrange an alternate water supply.
